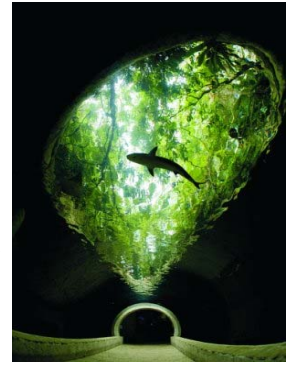
### Dallas "Then & Now" Tour
